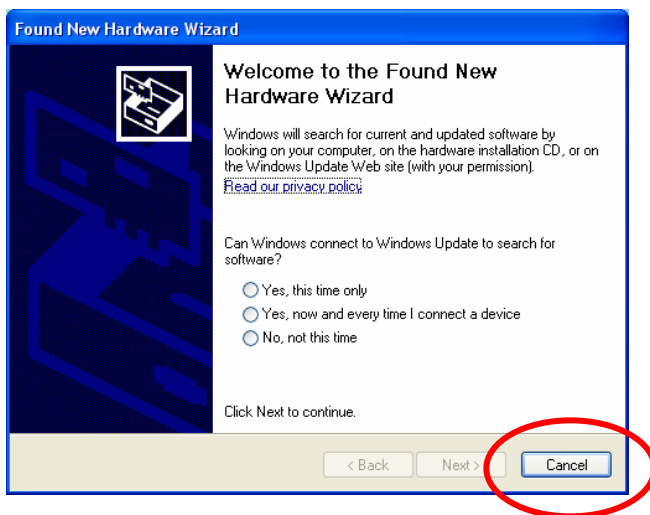

Quick Installation Guide

Before you proceed with the installation, it is important that you to know: A complete installation includes "**Driver**" and "**Application Program**", both parts can be installed easily from the software CD. Please follow these steps to install the software. It may takes around 3~4 minutes to complete the installation.

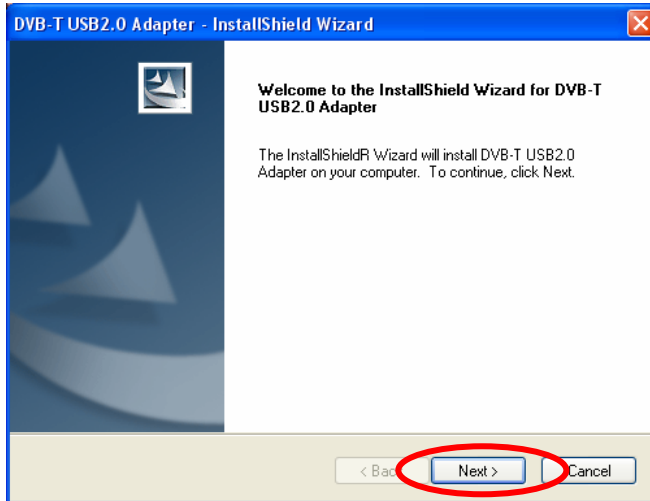
1. Insert your DVB-T USB STICK to your computer's USB socket and click **Cancel** when the **Found New Hardware Wizard** screen appears.



2. Insert the Installation CD into your CD-ROM, and then the installer will start automatically. Click the **Driver & SW Install** icon to begin the installation.



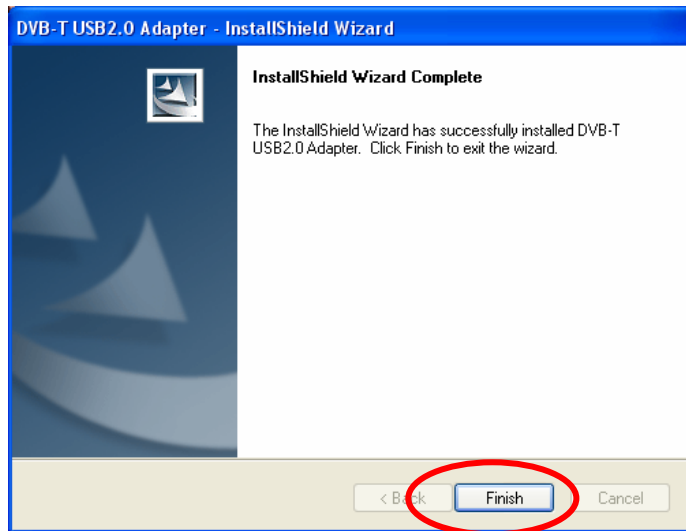
3. On the **DVB-T USB2.0 Adapter** screen, click "Next" to accept the InstallShield Wizard for driver installation.



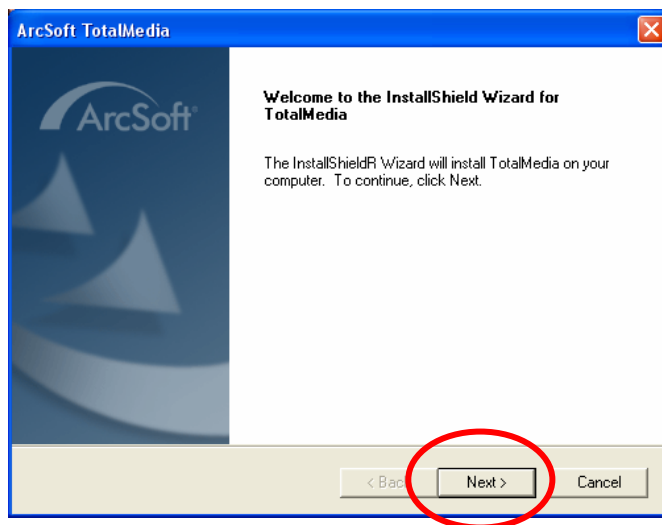
4. If you see the window "**Found New Hardware Wizard**" during the installation, below, please ignore it.



5. Click "**Finish**" to complete the installation.



6. After you install the **DVB-T USB2.0 Adapter** driver, the **Arcsoft TotalMedia installShield Wizard** will appear on your computer. Please click "**Next**" to continue and follow the directions to finish the installation.



How To Scan DTV-B Channels

TotalMedia can automatically scan for available channels. In fact, the first time you enter the TV module, the program will prompt you with an option to scan. Once it's done, just grab your remote control and start surfing. The scan results will be shown on the Channel List ; you can also save the list for future use.

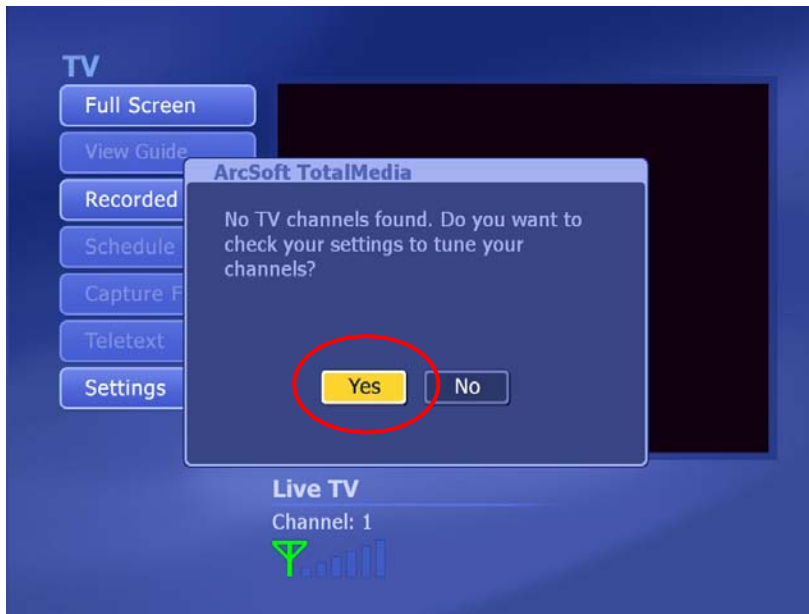


1. Double-click the icon  in your system tray.

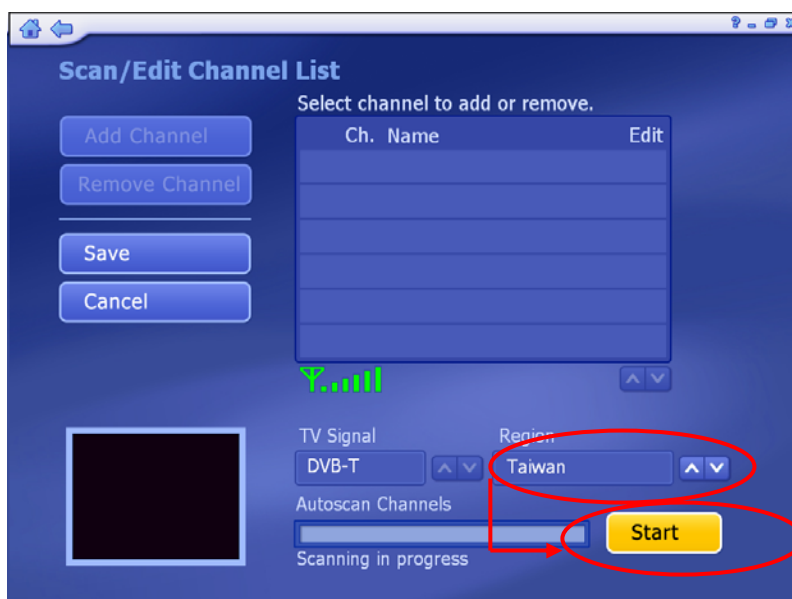
2. Choose the "TV" and click it.



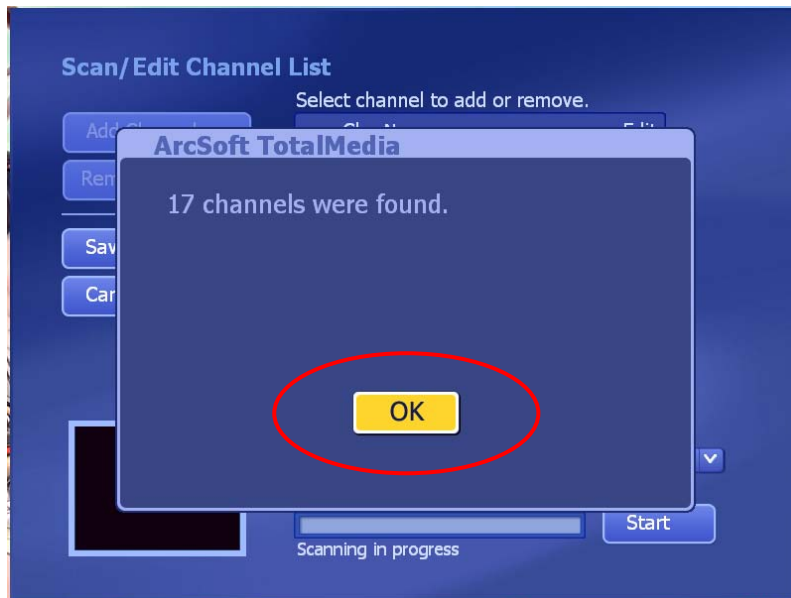
3. The program will ask you to scan channel when you first execute DVB-USB. Please click "Yes".



4. Please select a Region you are in and press "Start" to scan.



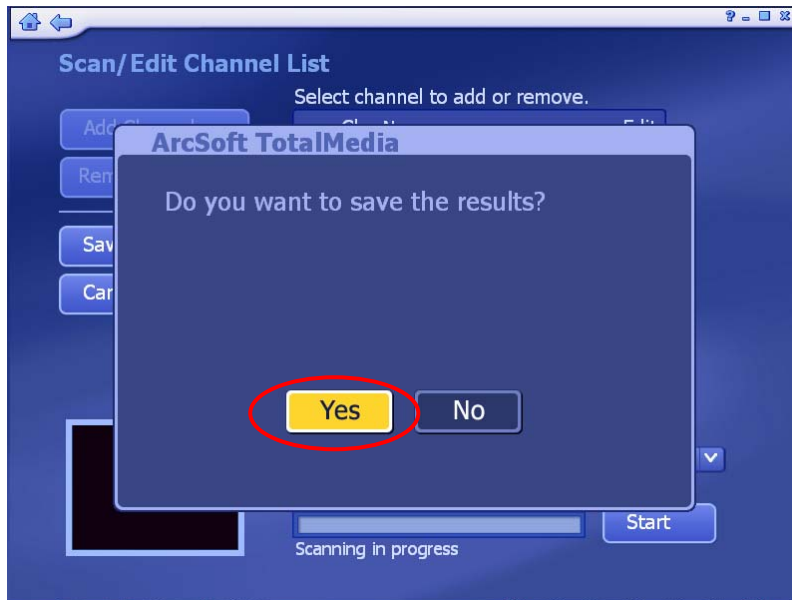
5. Please click "OK" when the scan is finished.



6. Please click "Save".



7. Please press "**Yes**" to save the results.

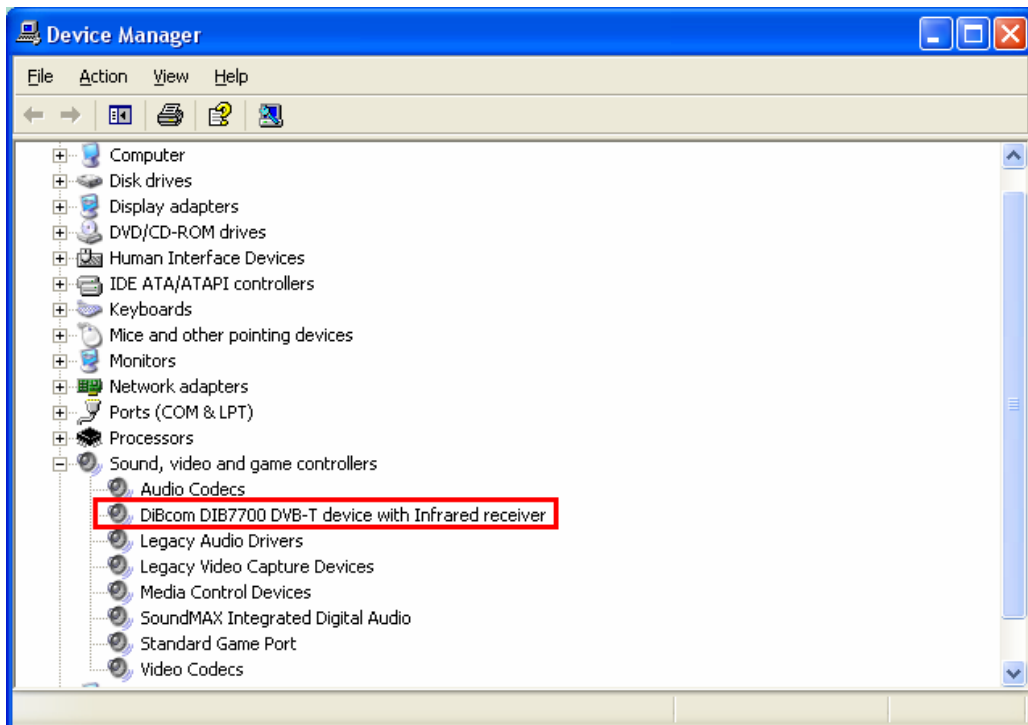


8. Congratulations! You can watch TV programs on your PC now.

Troubleshooting

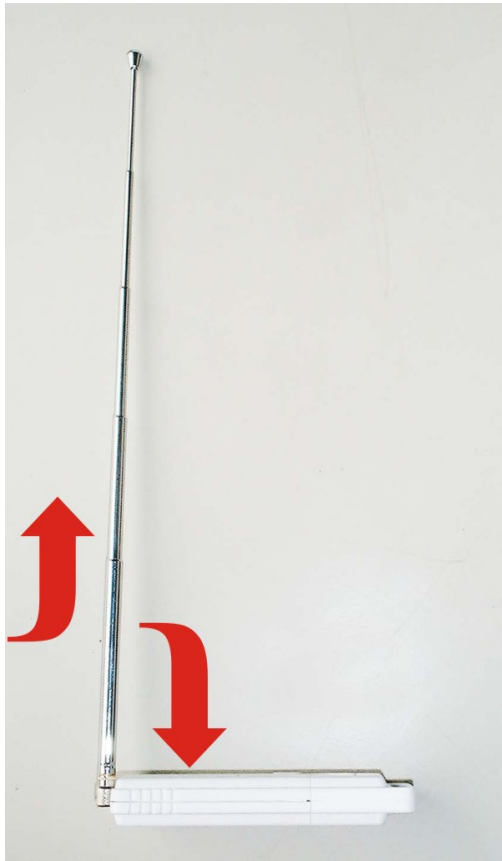
When no DVB-T program channel found during auto scan. Please perform the following steps.

- A. Whether NB/PC supports USB 2.0 and WinXP SP2 installed.
- B. Check the status of the drivers with Device Manager. You should see "DiBcom DIB7700 DVB-T device with Infrared receiver" drivers, in the "Sound, video and game controllers" section of Windows Device Manager.



If these drivers are not there, uninstalling and reinstalling the drivers can help. Use the Add/Remove Programs Control Panel applet to uninstall the drivers. Reinstalling the drivers should fix this problem.

- C. Consult local TV station for the DVB-T coverage area and whether it is Free-to-Air transmission.
- D. Change Antenna orientation (Pic 1) to get better signal. For weak DVB-T signal area, an optional FULL size DVB-T (Pic 2) Antenna is required.
